



PLEASE - LOCK YOUR CARS !!

The following message is the latest in an on-going series of e-mails from the PGA West Master Association Board, describing the Board's decisions, challenges and priorities. This message is being sent on behalf of the Master Association Board of Directors.

Dear PGA WEST Homeowners,

Within the last three days, PGA West Master Association has received 12 incident reports from residents that their vehicles were illegally entered. All of these incidents occurred in Res 1, on both sides of PGA Boulevard, behind both the Stadium and Palmer Gatehouses.

In each incidence, vehicles were parked outside - on the driveway or at the curb - and each vehicle was unlocked. Fortunately, no vehicles were damaged; and the most significant items stolen were phone chargers, sunglasses and loose change.

In response, our security patrols have been increased; patrolling patterns have been changed; and on Thursday evening, the Riverside Sheriff's Department was also on patrol.

We will keep you apprised of any additional incidents if they should occur - and again, we urge all residents and guests to keep their vehicles locked when parked outside.
