



PGA West Master Association May, 2018 Newsletter

The following message is the latest in an on-going series of e-mails from the PGA West Master Association Board, describing the Board's decisions, challenges and priorities. This message is being sent on behalf of the Master Association Board of Directors.

UPDATE - PGA BOULEVARD PAVING

With the most significant components of the boulevard repaving completed - including the removal and replacement of existing pavement, and lowering and raising of utilities - we move into the next phase of repaving; the slurry sealing of the remaining asphalt. Specifically, the areas that will be slurry sealed include:

- PGA Blvd - the northbound (exiting) lanes; between the Stadium Gate and Avenue 54
- Arnold Palmer
- Pete Dye Way

- Minor areas of asphalt in front of the Stadium, Palmer, Nicklaus and Weiskopf Gates

Our contractor, Aggregate Products, Inc., has prepared the following schedule for this work:

Tuesday, May 29 - applying slurry seal to the outside lane of PGA Blvd.; the outside lanes of Arnold Palmer; all of Pete Dye Way; and portions of each of the four gate entrances. With the exception of Pete Dye Way, all roads and gates will be open and accessible; however, it is anticipated that **Pete Dye Way will be closed to all traffic between the hours of 7:00 AM and 1:00 PM.**

Wednesday, May 30 - applying slurry seal to the inside lane of PGA Blvd; the inside lanes of Arnold Palmer; and the remaining portions of each gate entrance. All roads and gates will be open and accessible.

Members may encounter modest delays at each gate while the slurry seal is being applied.

Remaining Work - consists of replacing two speed bumps on PGA Boulevard; and restriping the entire Boulevard. It is anticipated that the speed bumps will be replaced on June 6 and 7; and that the restriping will be completed during the week of June 11.
