STATUS REPORT - PROGRESS ON FRONT ENTRANCE IMPROVEMENTS

With the recent removal of construction fencing, site grading, the installation of most landscaping and completion of the site lighting - one can clearly see how this new entrance will ultimately look. The picture above shows an evening view of the west side of the entrance.

There remain a number of work items yet to be completed, including:

- Installation of four ignitors for the fire features

- Completion of two pools for the cascading water features
- Installation of concrete caps on the walls and pilasters
- Additional stucco and painting

This work continues - and we are optimistic that the project will be completed by the end of November.

UPDATE - PGA BOULEVARD RE-STRIPING RE-SCHEDULED

Due to the recent parking lot improvements at The Private Club, the re-striping of PGA Boulevard was delayed late last month. This re-striping is now scheduled for the evening of Wednesday, November 14, beginning at 9:00 PM. Additional outreach will occur prior to that date to remind property owners of this work.

UPDATE - RE-PAINTING PLANTER TIERS

Re-painting of the planter tiers at the Palmer, Stadium and Nicklaus Gates is scheduled to begin Monday, November 12, beginning at 8:00 A.M. The crew will start at the Palmer Gate on Monday; Stadium Gate on Tuesday; and Nicklaus Gate on Wednesday. All painting is set for completion by Thursday, November 15.
